

Update - Ukraine Crisis

Event

Last Thursday, February 24, Russian President Vladimir Putin initiated a military invasion on Ukraine. As a result, Western countries and their allies have imposed sanctions, as the crisis continues to escalate.

Nexperia Response

Nexperia immediately put a dedicated team in action to closely monitor the developments in the region and ensure we comply with any sanctions and understand any impact of sanctions on business continuity.

In line with the sanctions, Nexperia complies with all applicable laws and regulations and is fully committed to complying with the new export control rules announced by US, UK, EU, and others.

Nexperia does not and will not have any direct business or cooperation with institutions in Russia, Belarus or Ukraine.

External Suppliers

The crisis event check was immediately triggered and the appropriate suppliers were contacted.

Confirmations were received that the Ukraine – Russia Crisis has no impact to their business operations.

Nexperia expects all their suppliers and business partners to comply with the sanctions and new export control rules.

Organization

The organization was reminded on the scope of the sanctions to the extent they apply to Nexperia and actions were taken to ensure compliance.

Overall assessment: As of today, the imposed sanctions and restrictions do not have an impact on our Logistics network and ability to ship products to our customers. Nexperia continues to closely monitor the developments and will provide further updates as necessary.
